



FEEDBACK INFORMATION: HEALTH AND SAFETY PROFILE FOR COUNTY CHILD WELL-BEING PROFILE

WORKPLACE AWARENESS TASK:

1. Make copies of the County Child Well-being Profile for everyone in your workplace/organization.
2. Facilitate a discussion of the questions below in your agency similar to the discussion you experienced in class:
 - a. If you have a large agency, you may want to have staff discuss the data in groups of 5-7 and report out to the whole group so everyone gets involved in the discussion.
 - b. Keep “public minutes” of the ideas shared on newsprint or a whiteboard to encourage the discussion to build on what has already been shared as you move to the next question.
3. Feel free to share any additional information or ideas that you learned in the session,
4. Record the key ideas shared on this sheet and bring it to the next session where we will be discussing health needs of families in the community. You may also want to jot additional ideas on the back.

What might be some important implications regarding the **population** statistics about children in the county found on the first page?

After reading the **Health Profile**, p. 2–3 (column 1) and the **Safety Profile**, p. 4, discuss the following questions and summarize the responses below:

1. What would you identify as key issues we need to be aware of regarding the **health and safety well-being of children** in the county?
2. Which of these would likely be key **health and safety issues** in our community as well?
3. Who is currently speaking up for the **health and safety needs** of these children and their families? (You may want to refer to the NEPEM Advocate definition.)
4. Are there additional ways those of us here could advocate (speak up) to address the **health and safety needs** of these children and their families?
5. What might that advocacy look like? For us as individuals? For us as a community organization? (Describe on back)
