



ANALYZING THE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PROFILE DATA

WORKPLACE AWARENESS TASK:

1. Make copies of the Community School District Profile for everyone in your workplace or organization. A clean copy was provided in class for this purpose.
2. Facilitate a discussion of the questions below with your colleagues:
 - a. If you have a large organization, you may want to have staff discuss the data in groups of 5-7 and report out to the whole group so everyone gets involved in the discussion.
 - b. Record the ideas shared on newsprint or a whiteboard.
3. Feel free to share any additional information or ideas that you learned in the session.
4. Record the key ideas shared on this sheet and bring it to the next session where we will discuss how to assist families in helping their children learn at home. You may also want to jot additional ideas on the back.

After reviewing the data in the *Community School District Profile*, discuss the following questions with your colleagues and summarize the responses below:

1. What are some key issues/needs that parents in the community face that impact helping their children be successful learners? (*Don't forget to look at data that might impact the amount of time parents have available to be with their children.*)

Put an asterisk in front of the issue/need that your group feels the most strongly about.

2. What are some ways the community as a whole can provide a supportive environment that would help parents take advantage of opportunities available to support their children as learners?
3. What are some ways the community might help families build supportive relationships in their neighborhoods and/or the larger community to help them address these needs?
4. Where might we find community resources to help families support their children to be successful learners?
5. What can you and your colleagues do to help carry out the ideas you have generated?
