Building Successful Partnerships (BSP) is the name of the National PTA's parent involvement program, and is based upon the National Standards for Parent and Family Involvement.

National PTA trainers deliver this program all over the country each year, upon request of state PTAs.

The program's purpose is to increase awareness of the National Standards for Parent/Family Involvement and to prepare attendees to implement parent involvement programs, plans, and policies in their local schools.

As a result of the sessions, the trainees become "presenters," giving presentations on this topic, implementing parent involvement locally, and consulting on the Parent Involvement Certification process. Using content from three BSP modules, one of which is specific to audiences of administrators, the trainers are now providing flexible sessions to meet the needs of PTAs.

Over 800 presenters have been trained to deliver Building Successful Partnerships since 2000 and include parents, PTA leaders, school administrators, and community leaders.
